As per the orders of the competent authority of the University, the following decisions have been taken with regard to the conduct of examination for the odd semester in the teaching departments of the University, Regional Campuses as well as constituent colleges/university colleges (courses governed by Credit Based System):

- The students will be given an open choice of attempting five questions out of total eight questions from any section.
- The time allowed for attempting the question paper will be three hours.
- 3. The Heads of the departments are required to follow the norms of physical distance between the students by formulating proper seating plan of the examination centre as per the guidelines/instructions issued by the Government of Punjab in view of COVID-19 pandemic. Apart from physical distance, other norms for safeguarding the health and maintenance of hygiene must also be observed.

As per the orders of the competent authority of the University, the following decisions have been taken with regard to conduct of examination for the odd semester in the teaching departments of the University, Regional Campuses as well as constituent colleges/university colleges (courses governed by Credit Based System):

- 1. The examinations for the odd semester classes will be conducted through off-line mode.
- The examinations of all the odd semesters except for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of various courses at GNDU Campus, Regional Campuses and Constituent Colleges/University Colleges (courses governed under Credit Based System) will be conducted within the window of period from 14<sup>th</sup> December 2020 (Monday) to 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2020 (Thursday).
- Since the classes of the first semester commenced late due to extended admission schedule in the wake of pandemic situation, the examinations of various courses at GNDU Campus, Regional Campuses and Constituent Colleges will be conducted within the window of period from 19th February (Friday), 2021 to 20th March, 2021 (Saturday).
- 4. It is suggested that the following measures as per the requirement can be adopted by the departments in order to ensure the smooth conduct of the examinations as per the guidelines issued by the Government of Punjab in view of COVID pandemic situation:
  - The examinations should be conducted in morning and evening sessions daily.
  - The examinations of various courses/classes (within the department) can be staggered as per the requirement, as the window for conducting the examination is five weeks. Preferably, the examination for each course/class can be split into weekly or fortnightly stages as per the number of courses/classes within the departments so that the students of one course/class can be relieved after a week or 15 days, when the examination of that particular course/class is over.
- Keeping in view the peculiar circumstances arising out of COVID-19 pandemic, the question papers will be set internally. However, it will be a one time measure and not to be treated as precedent in future.
- Since, the examinations are to be conducted through off-line mode, the guidelines issued
  from time to time by the Government of Punjab in view of COVID pandemic shall be
  strictly followed in letter and spirit by the departments.
